## **GLOBAL GRANT SCHOLARSHIP**

## Offered Through ROTARY CLUB OF AUSTIN

**PURPOSE:** Provide a grant for post-baccalaureate study in one of six Areas of Focus at an accredited university located in a country outside the United States.

AREAS OF FOCUS: Peace and Conflict Resolution; Disease Prevention and Treatment; Water and Sanitation; Maternal and Child Health; Basic Education and Literacy; and Economic and Community Development.

**AMOUNT:** \$30,000.

**GRANT TERM:** One to four years. The grant must start with the applicant's first year of study.

**INSTITUTIONAL ADMISSION:** The applicant must be admitted, on his or her own initiative, to the university program at the time of application.

**ROTARY PRESENCE:** The university must be in a location where Rotary has a presence in order for a club to serve as a host.

**APPLICATION:** An application form, to be provided by Rotary, must be filed prior to a date to be determined.

**INTERVIEWS:** The Rotary Club of Austin will conduct initial interviews. The person, recommended by the Club, will then interview with the District 5870 committee that will make the final selection.

**TIME SCHEDULE:** The initial interview will be in the late Fall 2020, District interview in the Spring 2021, and grantee to begin program at selected university in the Fall Semester 2021. Specific dates to be forthcoming.
